

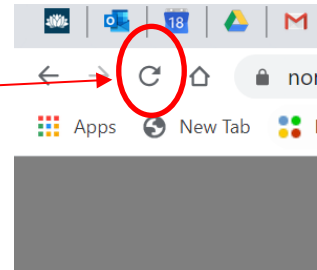
## Blayney Cattle section entries – Instructions

The following gives step-by-step instructions for entries and payment for the Blayney chow cattle section and schools section for 2021.

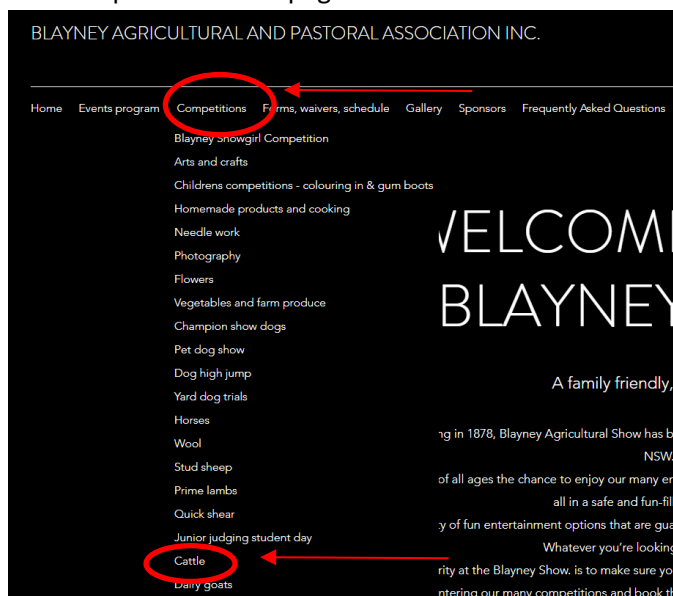

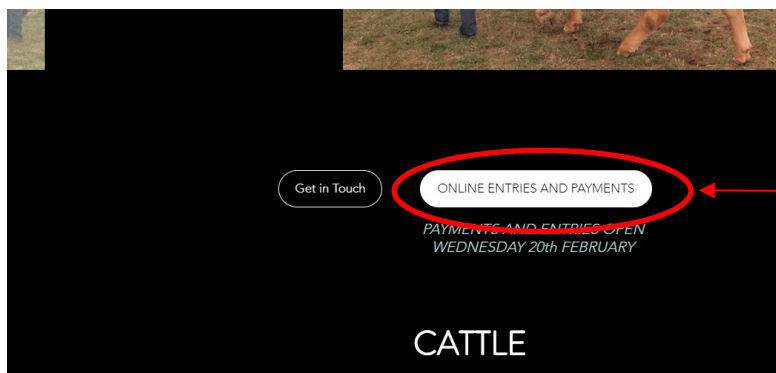


- At the top of the home page in the site menu select “Competitions > Cattle

**Step 3:** You will be taken to a landing page. Scroll to the bottom and select “click here to enter”





Make sure to enter the exhibits full details at the bottom of the page and select add another class to

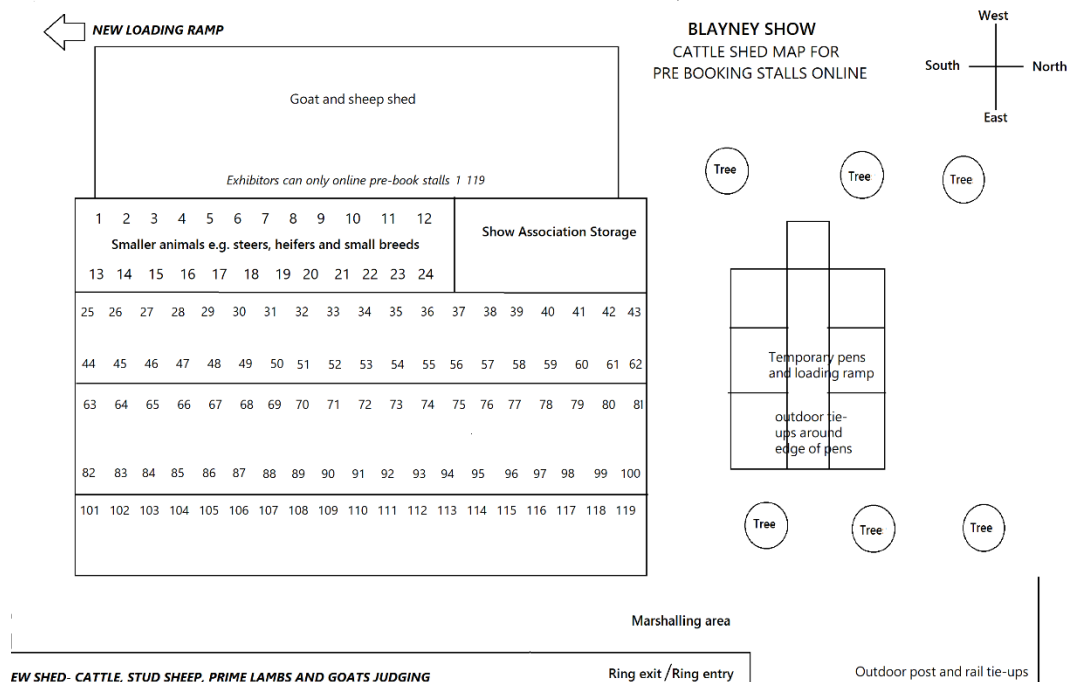
enter multiple animals/classes.
